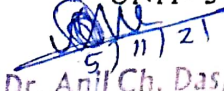

1.1 Significance of the study

(ii) The investigator also observes that 50% of Karbi Anglong people occupation is Agriculture and 50% were business and services.

(iii) The investigator in the field study observes that most of the people of the Karbi Anglong earn their annual income upto rupees 8,000-12,000 i.e. about 20%.

(iv) The investigator also observes that the total holding of the people of Karbi Anglong are mostly 3-4 Bighas with 45% and 5-6 Bighas 35% and 1-2 Bighas with 20%.
