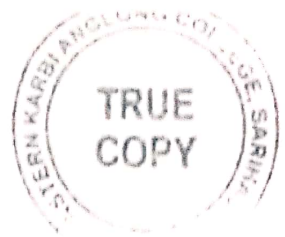
Finally, chairperson, Dr. Nayan Moni Medhi has addressed the remarks of the event conveyed by the resource persons.

Report on Remedial Classes Conducted by the Department of Education (Season 2023-24)


Introduction The Department of Education has always been committed to ensuring the academic success of all students. To address the challenges faced by students in understanding fundamental concepts and preparing effectively for examinations, the department initiated a series of remedial classes during the academic session 2023-24. These classes aimed to provide additional support to students and enhance their confidence by revisiting core topics and engaging in focused learning.

Objectives of the Remedial Classes

1. To strengthen students' understanding of basic concepts across various subjects.
2. To provide a platform for solving and discussing previous years' question papers.
3. To bridge the gap between the regular curriculum and individual learning needs.
4. To help students prepare effectively for upcoming examinations.

Planning and Implementation The remedial classes commenced after the completion of the regular syllabus. This timing allowed students to identify their weak areas and actively participate in additional learning sessions. Key highlights of the planning and implementation include:

1. **Faculty Involvement:**
 - Faculties from various disciplines collaborated to identify topics that required reinforcement.
 - A schedule was developed to ensure that remedial classes did not conflict with students' regular academic activities.
 - Faculty members adopted a student-centric approach, tailoring their teaching strategies to address common challenges.
2. **Curriculum and Activities:**
 - Core concepts from each subject were revisited in detail to strengthen the foundational knowledge of students.
 - Previous years' question papers were discussed thoroughly, with solutions provided for each question. This helped students understand the examination pattern, marking scheme, and key topics.
 - Doubt-clearing sessions were held regularly, allowing students to seek clarification on complex topics.
3. **Frequency and Duration:**
 - The remedial classes were conducted regularly throughout the academic season.
 - Each session lasted 1-2 hours, depending on the subject and the complexity of the topics being covered.
 - Weekend sessions were also organized for students who needed additional assistance.

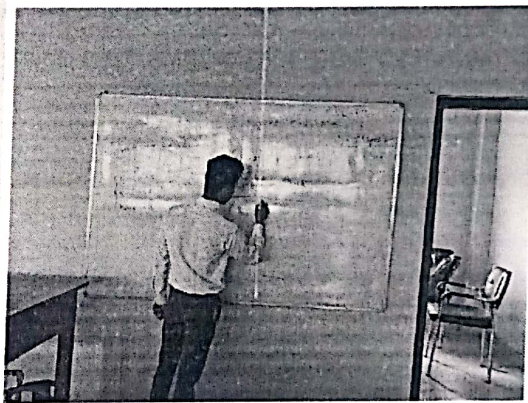

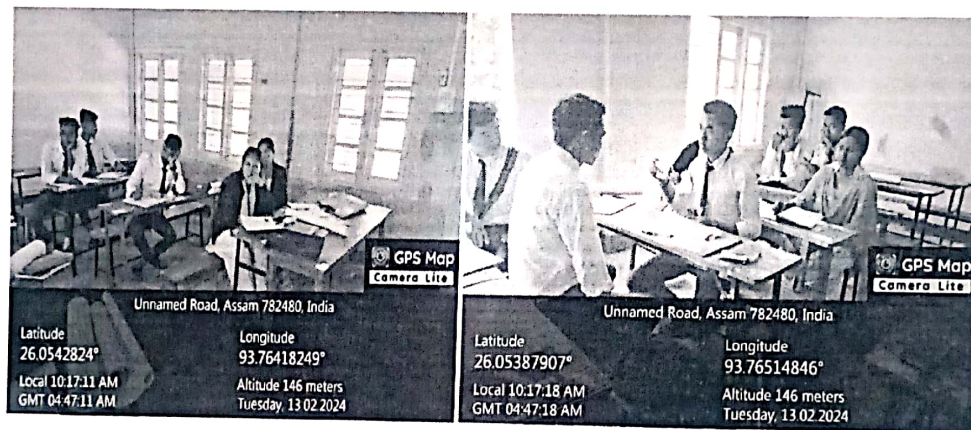
Arrangement of Group Discussions For Development of Better Understanding through Discussion




