

Key Features of the Divyangjan-Friendly, Barrier-Free Environment

- **Ramps and Pathways:** Smooth and wide ramps with anti-slip surfaces are installed at all entry and exit points, connecting essential facilities.
- **Accessible Entrances:** Doors and entrances are designed for wheelchair accessibility with adequate space and automated features in key areas.

2. Academic and Support Services

- **Accessible Study Materials:** Course materials are provided in accessible formats, including braille, large print, and digital alternatives.
- **Support Staff:** Dedicated personnel are available to assist Divyangjan in navigating campus facilities and participating in activities.

5. Policies and Awareness

- **Grievance Redressal Mechanism:** A system is in place to address accessibility-related concerns promptly.
- **Sensitization Programs:** Regular awareness campaigns and workshops are organized to promote understanding and acceptance of diversity.

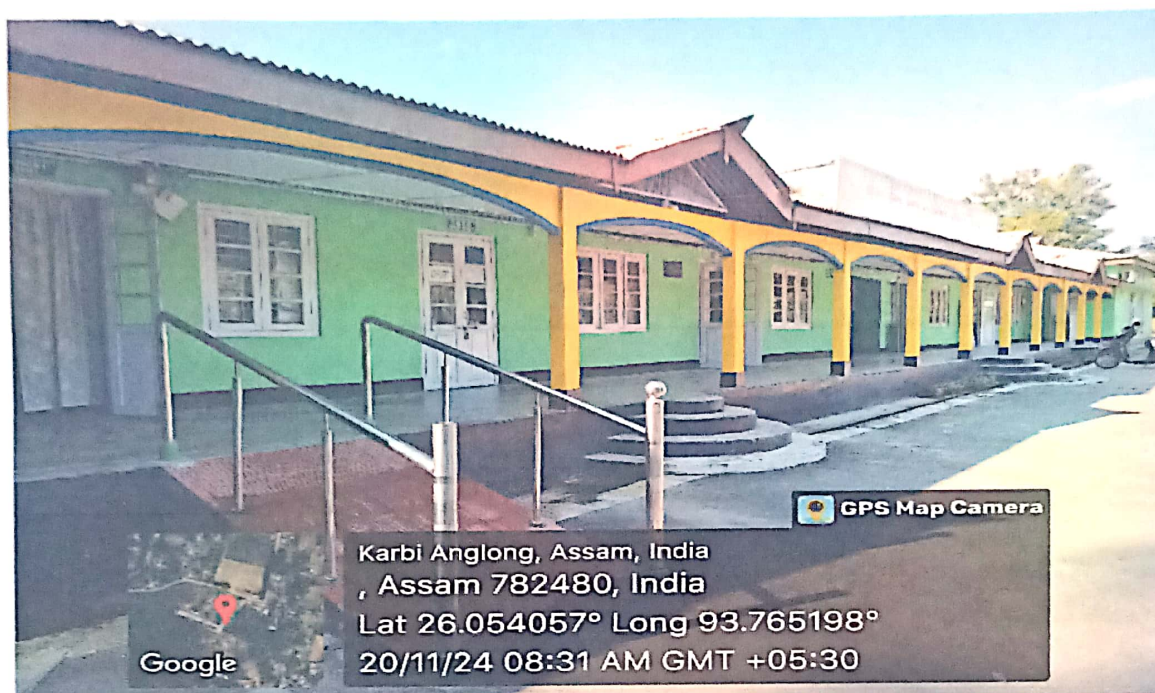
Future Plans

- Conduct periodic audits to ensure continuous improvement in accessibility.

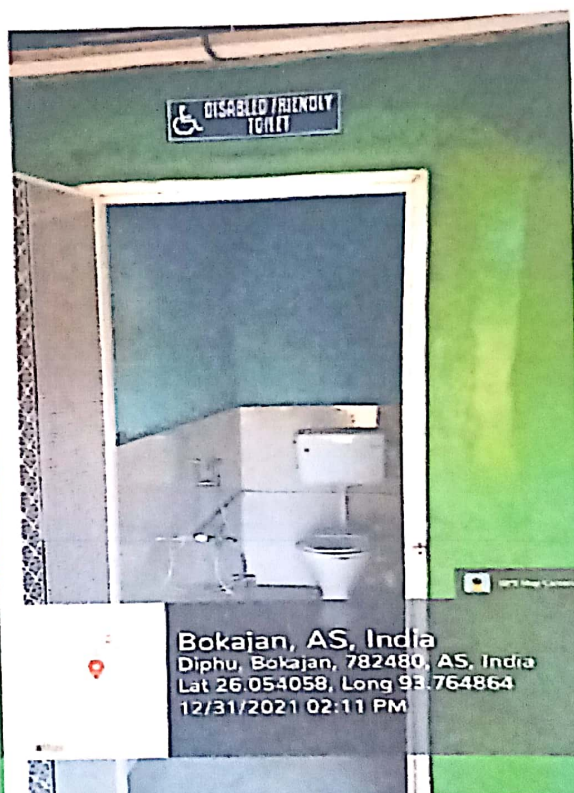



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Ramps for Easy Access to Classroom:
