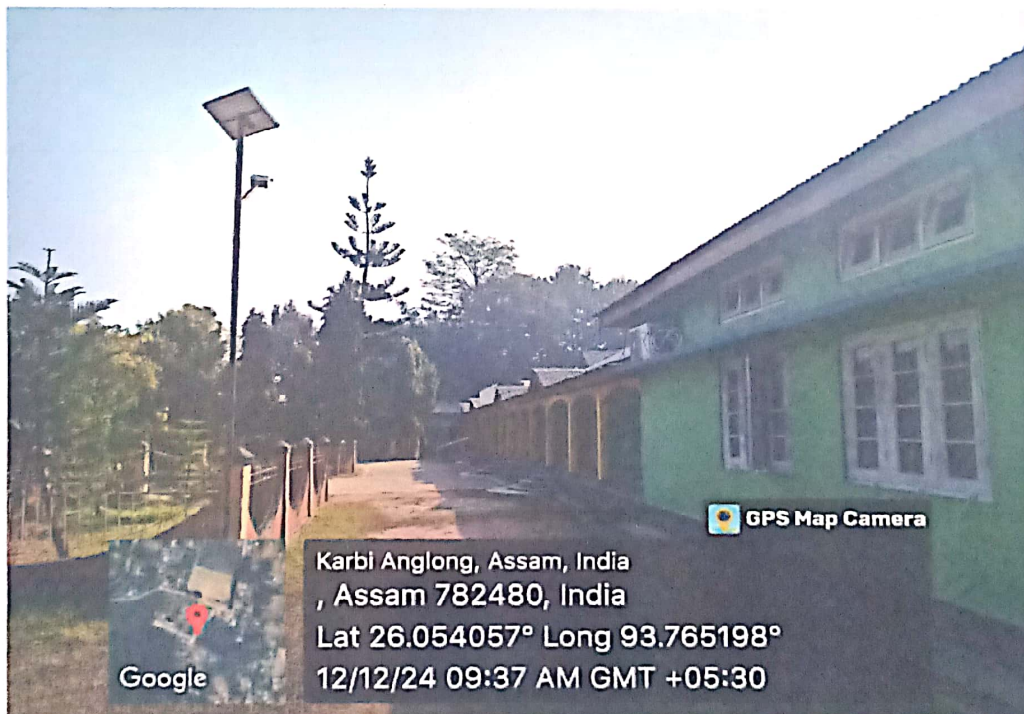
Institutional Initiatives for Greening the Campus

1. Restricted Entry of Automobiles


- **Objective:** Reduce air and noise pollution on campus.

Pedestrian-Friendly Pathways

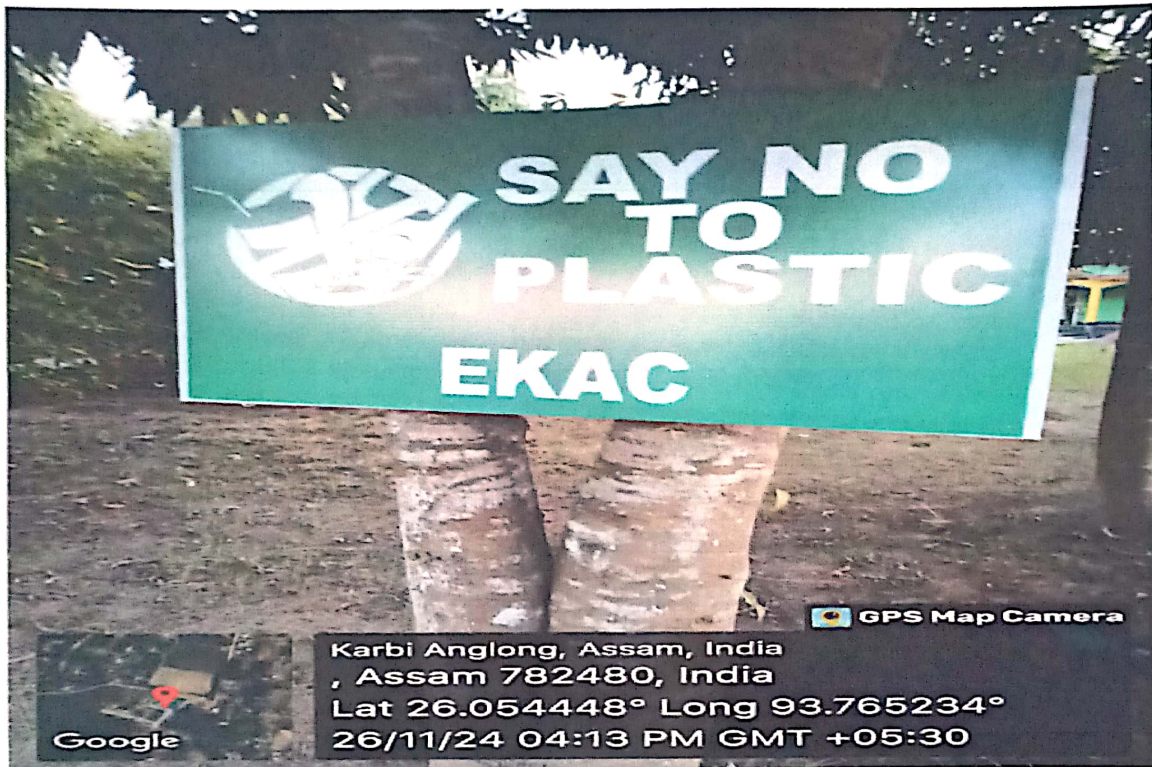
- **Objective:** Encourage walking and ensure safety and comfort for pedestrians.

 - Awareness campaigns to educate stakeholders about the harmful effects of plastic.

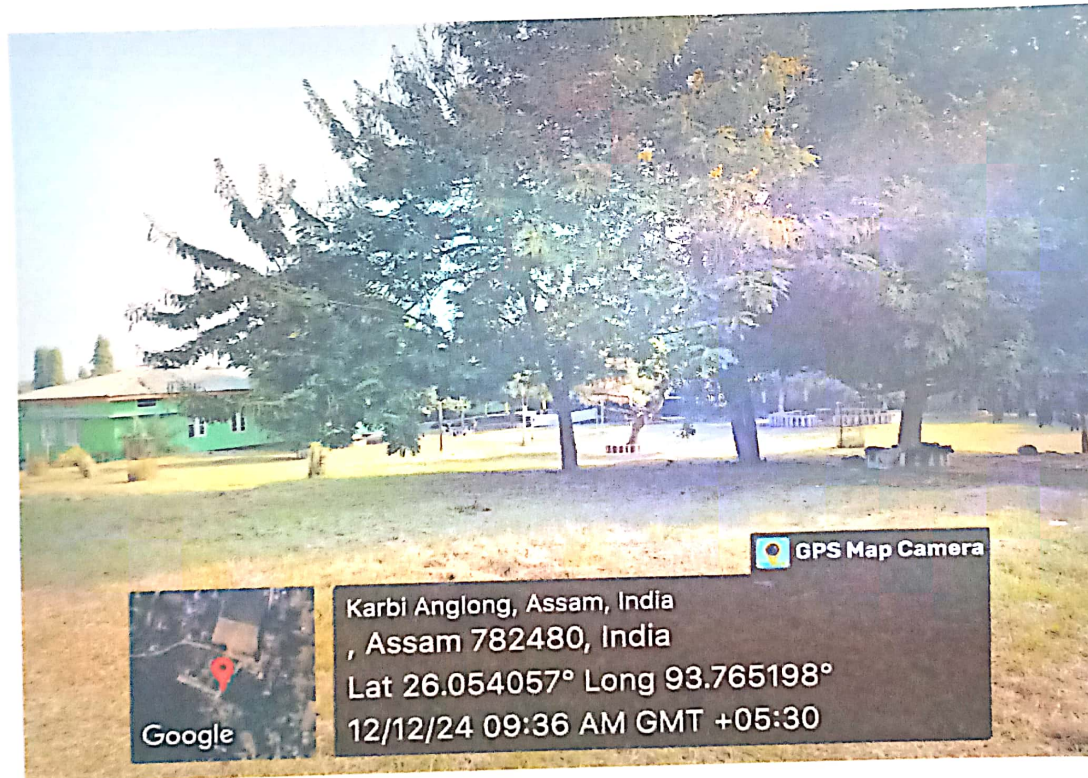
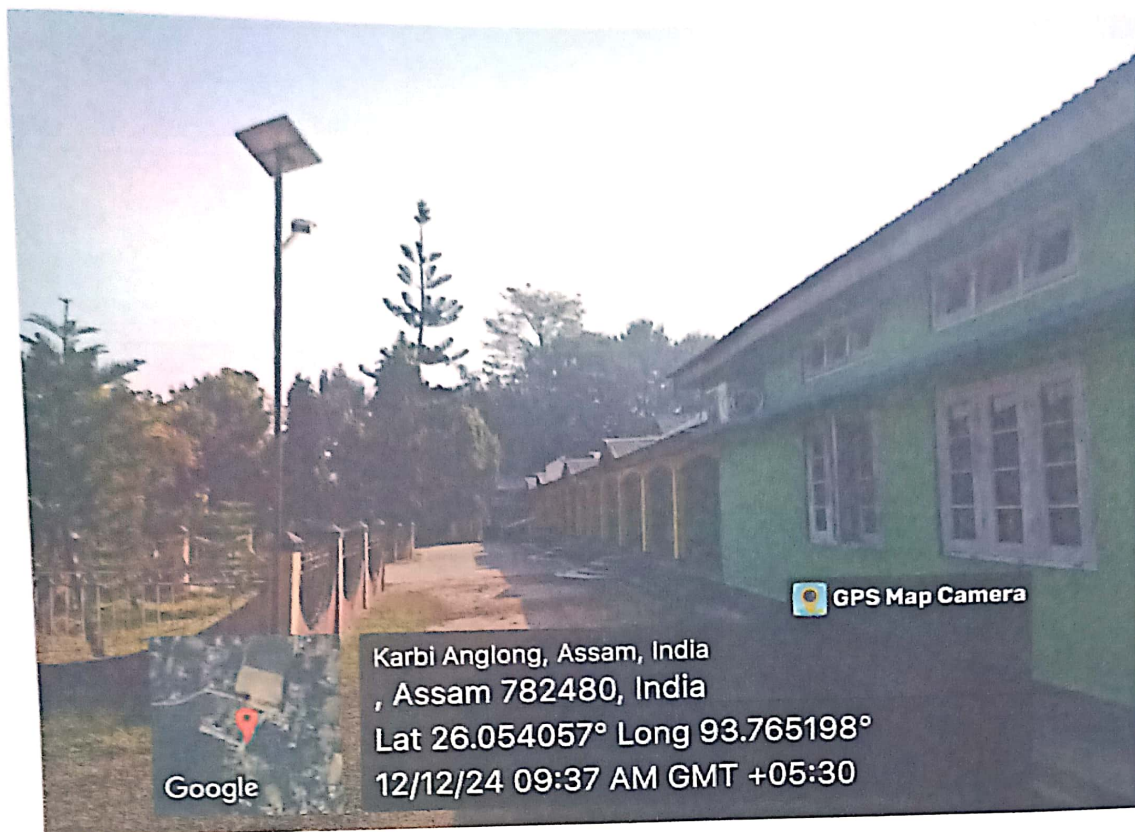



5. Landscaping with Trees and Plants
